Rule developments - Continuing Airworthiness

Review of Part-66 (applicable Jun 2024 except a few points in Jun 2023)

- [COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION \(EU\) 2023/989](#) which, among other things, update basic knowledge syllabus and introduces new training methods/teaching technologies.
- Application in June 2023: definitions (management systems harmonisation and complex motor-powered aircraft) and to facilitate a smooth transition due to the evolution of the basic knowledge standard.
